On March 15, Bolivian President Jaime Paz Zamora appointed Carlos Saavedra Bruno as the new interior minister, replacing Guillermo Capobianco. After being linked to drug traffickers in the March 4 issue of the Miami Herald, Capobianco resigned March 13. In addition to the former interior minister, police commander Gen. Felipe Carvajal and anti-drug trade official, Faustino Rico Toro, resigned. They were also mentioned in the Herald. (Basic data from AFP, 03/15/91)
