## **Costa Rica: Note On August Inflation**

According to a report released Sept. 4 by the government's statistics agency, the consumer price index rose 1.4% in August. The lowest monthly inflation rate thus far in 1991 occurred in March, at 1.27%, and the highest in February, 2.9%. The cumulative rate for the first eight months of the year is 18.26%, compared to 27.25% for the same period in 1990. (Basic data from ACAN-EFE, 09/04/91)
