## **Intibuca Department, Honduras: Nine Agricultural Workers Killed In Land Disputes**

On Sept. 11, Oscar Castillo, National Agrarian Institute (INA) regional director for Intibuca department, told reporters that nine agricultural workers were killed in disputes over a total of 500 ha. of land. Castillo said that the incidents, which took place in San Isidro, Intibuca, involved a conflict between persons affiliated with the National Agricultural Workers Union (UNC), and members of the National Federation of Honduran Agricultural Workers (FENACH).
