## **Spain Donates 32 Vehicles To Nicaraguan Police**

On Sept. 27, Martin Cinto, member of a delegation headed by Spanish Secretary of State Security Rafael Vera Fernandez, told Interior Ministry officials that his government plans to donate 32 vehicles to the national police force. The vehicles are scheduled to arrive in November. Delegation member Fernando Mariscal will remain in Nicaragua to act as a liaison between Spanish and Nicaraguan officials in training the national police force. Interior Minister Carlos Hurtado told reporters that the Spanish government would also provide aid for programs aimed at professionalization of military officers and troop strength cutbacks of the Sandinista Popular Army (EPS).
