## **Panama & Belize Request Observer Status In Central American Parliament**

On Oct. 22 in Guatemala City, Hector Manuel Klee, spokesperson for the Central American Parliament, told reporters that the Panamanian and Belizean governments had formally requested observer status in the Parliament. According to Klee, the Panamanian request had been approved at the last meeting of the Parliament's "preparatory commission."
