On Oct. 21, Quinteleito Mora, chief of the Judicial Technical Police (PTJ) weapons registration division, told reporters that illegal weapons possession in Panama is common. The number of unregistered firearms, he said, is estimated at 100,000. Only 50,000 Panamanians possess legally registered weapons. (Basic data from AFP, 10/21/91)
