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\$10 Million Credit Line To Expand Andean Nation Imports From Britain

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On May 21, the London-based Export Credits Guarantee Department announced a \$10 million credit line for Andean Pact nations to purchase goods and services from British companies. The credit line, destined to support trade expansion by the Midland Montagu bank in the region, will be administered by the Andean Development Corporation (Corporacion Andina de Fomento).
