On May 25, the Andean Pact headquarters in Lima reported that in 1990 the five nations' combined exports to the rest of the world increased 19%, the highest growth rate since 1980 (24%). Exports to the Rest of the World, 1990 Venezuela \$16.5 billion Peru 3.3 Colombia 6.2 Ecuador 2.72 Bolivia .9 Intra-pact exports last year totaled \$1.3 billion, an increase of 24% over 1989. Intra-regional trade reached the highest level of the previous 20 years. Venezuela accounted for \$488 million worth of intra-regional trade, and Colombia, \$377 million.
