On Nov. 4, Presidency Minister Antonio Lacayo told reporters that the consumer price index rose 5.9% in October, bringing the cumulative rate for the year to 7.5%. Lacayo said the main contributor to inflation last month was an increase in utility rates, result of government outlays for electricity from Costa Rica.
