On June 5, the official statistics bureau (DANF) reported that the consumer price index rose 2.2% in May, bringing the cumulative inflation rate for the year to 14.7%, and the 12- month rate to 31.4%. Inflation for the month of May was 0.25% higher than the same month last year. The annual rate for 1990 was 32.36%. (Basic data from Notimex, 06/05/91)
