300 Salvadoran Refugees In Nicaragua To Be Repatriated

On Dec. 3 in Managua, Salvadoran and Nicaraguan deputy foreign ministers and representatives of the UN High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) met to discuss plans for the repatriation of 300 Salvadoran refugees currently living in Nicaragua. In March this year, 800 Salvadorans were repatriated. During the 1980s, an estimated 4,000 Salvadorans were admitted to Nicaragua as refugees.
