On Deportation Of Undocumented Foreigners From Guatemala

On Dec. 3, Guatemalan judicial system spokespersons reported that 4,041 undocumented foreigners had been deported thus far in 1991. Included in the tally were 2,510 Hondurans, 1,185 Salvadorans, 65 Nicaraguans, 79 Mexicans, 48 Peruvians, 24 Dominicans, 56 Ecuadorans, 36 Colombians, 21 Indians, four Chinese, one Japanese, four Koreans and one English national. Most of the detentions occurred in Chiquimula, Izabal department, and along the Mexican-Guatemalan border. (Basic data from ACAN-EFE, 12/03/91)
