On Dec. 5, government officials reported that the consumer price index rose 0.95% in November, bringing the combined rate for the past six months to -6.4%. The CPI declined in May, June and August. The cumulative rate for the year as of Nov. 30 was 765.8%. (Basic data from Notimex, 12/05/91)
