Honduras: Brewery In San Pedro Sula Target Of Rpg-7 Rocket Attack

In a Dec. 3 communique, the Morazanista Patriotic Front (FPM) claimed responsibility for a RPG-7 rocket attack on the Cerveceria Hondurena brewery in San Pedro Sula. The FPM said the attack was "against the alliance of the government, army and transnationals." The brewery, the only such facility in Honduras, was founded by the US-based Standard Fruit Company, and has since incorporated Honduran investors. Cerveceria Hondurena also operates the local Coca Cola franchise. Brewery executives say damages are estimated at US\$7 million. (Basic data from Agence France-Presse, 12/03/91, 12/04/91)
