On Dec. 8, Mutual Support Group (GAM) president Nineth de Garcia told reporters that a common grave containing the remains of six persons was found in Pajulil, Solola department. Most of the victims, she said, were adolescents. Carlos Grajeda, coordinator of the forensic medicine division of the local court, said the murders took place between 1978 and 1982. Garcia noted that another common grave containing the corpses of five persons was found in the same area. (Basic data from ACAN-EFE, 12/08/91)
