On Dec. 9, police spokespersons reported that French citizen Pascale Viau was shot and killed and his traveling companion injured near San Lucas Toliman, Atitlan, Solola department, known as a popular tourism site. The two men were reportedly robbed before the assailants fired on their vehicle. The French Embassy in Guatemala City dispatched a team to investigate the incident.
