On Dec. 14 in San Salvador, at least 20,000 people participated in a peace demonstration organized by the Permanent National Debate Committee (CPDN), an umbrella group comprised of 60 political, labor and human rights organizations. CPDN director Edgar Palacios said the marchers supported a cease-fire accompanied by political, economic and military reforms, including a purge of the armed forces.
