## **El Salvador: Rebel Combatants To Receive Police Training In European & South American Countries**

On Dec. 14, rebel commander "Adonai" told reporters that the Farabundo Marti National Liberation Front (FMLN) plans for about 10,000 rebels to receive police academy training in Sweden, Spain, Uruguay and Colombia after Jan. 1. Upon return to El Salvador, they would be integrated into the new Civilian National Police (PNC). Adonai said he would be among rebels receiving police training abroad.
