On Aug. 3, the National Statistics and Census Institute (INDEC) reported that the consumer price index rose 2.6% in July, for a 12-month accumulated inflation rate of 178.3%. Wholesale prices in July increased an average 0.4%. (Basic data from AFP, 08/03/91)
