Chile: 1.8% Consumer Price Inflation In July

On Aug. 5, the National Statistics Institute (INE) reported that the consumer price index rose 1.8% in July, bringing the accumulated rate for the year to 10.1%. In 1990, the January-July rate was 13%. The Treasury and Economy Ministries predict about 18% inflation for 1991, compared to 27.3% last year. (Basic data from AFP, 08/05/91)
