The Brazilian automobile industry produced 102,835 vehicles in July, the highest monthly figure in 1991. In the first seven months of the year, total output was 506,412 trucks, automobiles and buses, a 12% increase over the same period of 1990. Exports in January-July 1991 came to 94,559 vehicles, a 17% decline compared to 1990. (Basic data from AFP, 08/07/91)
