Uruguay: \$565.3 Million Surplus, Errors & Omissions Category Of Balance Of Payments, First Half 1991

According to a recent report by the Central Bank, the "errors and omissions" category of balance of payments registered an unprecedented \$565.3 million surplus during the first half of the year. The surplus was attributed to informal sales to tourists or other non-residents, and capital repatriation. The latter is comprised of repatriation of flight capital, or inflows from Uruguayans' foreign accounts. [Basic data from El Pais (Montevideo), 08/13/91]
