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## **World Market Sugar Surplus Predicted For 1990/91 Season**

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On Aug. 9, London brokers ED & F Man Sugar Ltd. released a report predicting a world market surplus of over 4 million metric tons of sugar at the close of the 1990/91 season. Much of the surplus exists in the form of white sugar, and to a certain extent has resulted in restocking in importer nations such as the US, Canada, India and Mexico. In contrast, raw sugar stocks held by exporters and refiners are non-existent or very low. (Basic data from Inter Press Service, 08/09/91)

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
