## **Colombia: Import Spending, June 1991**

On Aug. 14, the Colombian Foreign Trade Institute (INCOMEX) reported import spending of \$3.58 billion for the month of June. The figure for June 1990 was \$3.36 billion. According to INCOMEX, private sector imports in June 1991 came to \$3.2 billion, up 17.5% compared to last year. Public sector imports declined by 41%, from \$626 million (1990) to \$369 million. Public sector expenditures for imported military hardware, fuels and communications equipment was down compared to last year. (Basic data from Xinhua, 08/14/91)
