Colombia: On Oil Output, First Half 1991

In a statement released Aug. 14, the state-run oil company (ECOPETROL) reported average crude output of 22,927 barrels per day during the first half of the year. Financial losses resulting from reduced output are estimated at \$215 million. The production decline is attributed in part to rebel sabotage: attacks on oil facilities during the January- June period numbered over 100. (Basic data from Xinhua, 08/14/91)
