Brazil: Beef Exports To U.S. Resume

On Aug. 13, Agriculture Minister Antonio Cabrera told reporters that Brazilian beef exports to the US had resumed, after a year-long hiatus due to inadequate sanitation controls. According to Cabrera, export revenues from beef sales to the US have averaged \$100 million per year, and are likely to increase. Over the past year, the government invested \$4 million in the installation of quality control laboratories aimed at resumption of beef exports to the US and the European Economic Community.
