On Jan. 30, rightist politician Mario Castejon Prendes told reporters that a bomb exploded outside of his Guatemala City home at 2:00 a.m., causing material damage but no casualties. Castejon Prendes asserted that former president Vinicio Cerezo and his brother Milton Cerezo were behind the attack.
