## **Brazil: \$777 Million Trade Surplus In July**

On Aug. 19, government sources reported that the trade surplus for July came to \$777 million, the lowest monthly surplus registered thus far in 1991. Export revenues totaled \$2.751 billion, and import spending, \$1.974 billion. The accumulated trade surplus for the first seven months of the year came to \$7.6 billion.
