On March 10, the Inter-American Investment Corporation (IIC) announced approval of a US\$1.35 million loan for the Industria Agricola Tierra Fria, headquartered in El Tejar, Chimaltenango department. The loan is part of a US\$2.7 million expansion program, including installation of new freezing plant, and modernization of the company's fruit and vegetable canning operations. The IIC, an affiliate of the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB), is dedicated to support of private enterprise in Latin America and the Caribbean.
