Honduran Government To Receive US\$42 Million Worth Of Wheat Under U.S. PL-480 Program

On March 7 in Tegucigalpa, US sources announced a US\$42 million donation of wheat under Washington's PL-480 program. The wheat shipments will take place over a three-year period, and are equivalent to 80% of domestic consumption. Revenue obtained by the government through sales of the grain at international market prices is earmarked for financing environmental conservation and cooperative programs. Between 1980 and 1991, PL-480 food aid to Honduras totaled US\$185 million. Over the same period, US military aid came to US\$500 million.
