## **Panama: 1991 Sales Of Contraband From U.S. Military Bases**

According to local media reports on March 2, the Statistics and Census Administration estimates 1991 sales of contraband items from commissaries located on US military bases in the canal zone at US\$31 million, a record low for the past five years.
