On March 23 in Panama City, Sergei Ilyn and Elena Alekseeva, Russian Trade House president and vice president, respectively, told reporters that a Russian consortium plans to open a commercial bank in Panama within the next nine months. Initial capital will total about US\$3 million. According to Alekseeva, in the first phase of operations, the bank will focus on guaranteeing foreign investments in Russia.
