## **Cuba & Venezuela Finalize Cooperation Agreements**

On Sept. 17, Cuban and Venezuelan officials signed four bilateral cooperation agreements at the conclusion of a three- day visit in Havana by Venezuelan Foreign Minister Armando Duran. The agreements were focused on economic development, science, culture and anti-narcotics efforts. At a press conference, Duran said the issue of increased Venezuelan oil shipments to Cuba was not discussed. According to Duran, at present, Venezuela exports 60,000 barrels per day of crude to Cuba as part of a trilateral accord finalized a decade ago by the governments of Cuba, Venezuela and the Soviet Union.
