## **Costa Rica: Principal Airline's Financial Losses, 1st Quarter 1992**

On March 16, Mario Quiros Lara, president of Costa Rican Airlines (Lineas Aereas Costarricenses SA-LACSA), told reporters that financial losses in first quarter 1992 totaled US\$1.4 million, down from US\$6 million for the same period last year. In an attempt to boost efficiency and reduce the company's debt, said Quiros, plans to purchase two new Air Bus A-310s have been cancelled. At present, the LACSA fleet is comprised of four Air Bus A-320s and two Boeing 727-200s. (Basic data from Notimex, 03/16/92)
