On April 8, military spokespersons told reporters that a joint police and army patrol had arrested 10 persons believed to be responsible for the April 2 theft of weapons from army installations. The spokespersons added that stolen weapons recovered at the time of the arrests included 27 AK-47 rifles, three submachineguns, four RPG-7 rocket launchers, four boxes of ammunition, and one radio transmitter.
