On April 24, public health officials reported confirmation of 14,300 cases of malaria since Jan. 1, a 38% increase compared to the same period last year. According to Laura Julia Salgado, head of the Health Ministry's malaria prevention program, over the past five years, malaria victims averaged 50,000 per annum.
