On May 11, TAN-SAHSA airline pilots launched a sit-down strike at the Toncontin Airport in Tegucigalpa to protest the recent dismissal of a pilot, and to demand collective bargaining rights. Several flights were delayed, but none were cancelled. Salvadoran airline company TACA recently acquired stock in TAN-SAHSA, the only Honduran international air carrier.
