## **80% Of Honduran 1991/1992 Coffee Harvest Sold**

On July 8, Osmond Maduro, president of the Coffee Exporters Association (AEC), told reporters that 1.9 million 46-kg. sacks, or 80% of the 1991/1992 coffee harvest bound for export, has already been sold. The remaining 500,000 sacks, he said, will be marketed before next September. Coffee sales on the world market derived from the 1990/1991 harvest sold for a total US\$155 million, equivalent to 15% of all Honduran exports.
