## **Paraguay: US\$190 Million World Bank Loan**

On Nov. 15 in Asuncion, government spokespersons said Shaid Husain, vice president of the World Bank's Latin American and Caribbean division, will arrive in the capital Nov. 24 to finalize a US \$190 million loan. Since December 1951, the Paraguayan government has received 33 loans totaling US\$503.6 million from the World Bank and its affiliate, the International Development Association (IDA). Husain's visit marks the resumption of loan activities with the World Bank after an eight-year hiatus. (Basic data from Agence France-Presse, 11/15/91)
