## **Guatemala: Note On Projected Tourism Revenues, 1992**

In Oct. 26 statements to reporters, a spokesperson from the government's tourism office (Instituto Guatemalteco de Turismo, INGUAT) said total 1992 tourism revenues were projected to exceed US \$243 million. Total tourism revenues in 1991 were US\$212 million. The spokesperson added that about 540,000 foreign tourists will have visited the country during 1992, up from 512,000 in 1991.
