On Dec. 12, the Central Bank reported that medium- and long-term foreign debt totaled US\$16.17 billion, and outstanding short-term debt, US\$2.1 billion. The private sector accounts for a third of the debt. Under a debt-equity swap program initiated in 1985, the government has reduced its foreign debt by US\$10.674 billion.
