Guatemala: National Police Issues Crime Statistics For 1992

On Jan. 4, National Police spokesperson Fredy Garcia told reporters that during 1992 police registered a total of 2,062 assassinations. Garcia said the total was 686 less than the number of killings reported in 1991. Of the total, 1,164 persons were killed with firearms, 685 were stabbed to death, 130 were hanged, and 41 died from strangulation. Garcia added that an additional 3,875 persons were reported wounded during 1992, including 1,608 who suffered gunshot wounds and 1,904 with knife wounds. He also said a total of 1,040 persons were assaulted during 1992. (Source: Agencia Centroamericana de Noticias-Spanish news service EFE, 01/04/93)
