On Feb. 23, the government's official gazette reported that Foreign Trade Minister Ricardo Cabrisas Ruiz authorized registration at Cuba's Chamber of Commerce of the following companies: Motores Internacionales, S.A. (Panama); Comercial Panamex, S. A. de C.V. (Mexico); Talleres Ferruz, Marcafix, S.A., and Piramide International Trading, S.A. (Spain).
