According to a recent report by Salomon Brothers, private sector direct and indirect investment in Latin America last year totaled US\$40 billion. The figures for 1990 and 1989 were US\$13.4 billion and US\$5 billion, respectively. Mexico accounted for US\$16.1 billion of the regional total last year. Next in the ranking were Brazil, US\$11.6 billion; Argentina, US\$5.1 billion; Venezuela, US\$4.8 billion; and, Chile, US\$1.7 billion. Most of the inflow derived from capital repatriation.
