Audacity was founded by Dominic Mazzoni and Roger Dannenberg in 1999 at Carnegie Mellon University. It was released at SourceForge.net in May 2000.



Audacity is an open source piece of software made by volunteers and is distributed by GNU General Public License. It is free for download and it is encouraged to be used, studied and shared with others.

Audacity allows you to

- Record live audio
- Edit mp3, wav and AIFF audio files
- Mix recordings, adjust volumes
- Apply Filters to sound files
