FINAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CC MEETING

For those driving to Manhattan, KS, by now you should have received a map of the town and the campus. If not, let me know and I will you send one as soon as possible. For those flying into Manhattan, we will provide transportation from the airport to the motel. There is only one gate, one airline, and one baggage pick-up, thus we are confident we can find you! If no one is there to meet you, phone numbers to call are : (913) 532-6629 (Briggs-work); (913) 539-9215 (Briggs-Home); (913) 532- 7094 (Knapp-work); (913) 537-3385 (Knapp-Home). If you can't get hold of anyone, then simply take a taxi from the airport to the motel. For your information, US-AIR Express (which is the airline you will fly to Manhattan) is in terminal A in Kansas City. If you arrive at another terminal in Kansas City (there are three of them), take "THE RED BUS" to terminal A.

The motel is the Super-8. There is no restaurant in the motel, but there is one right next door. In addition, across the street is the Manhattan Town Center Mall which has a food court (typical fast food) and a mexican cafe which has a bar! Applebee's is at the other end of the Town Center. And if you go thru the Town Center you are downtown where there are a few more bars and Harry's Uptown, yet another restaurant.

All meetings will be held in the Kansas State University Student Union in room 206. We will provide transportation from the motel to the union. On Wednesday AM, for the EXEC meeting, the rides will leave the motel at 8:00am for an 8:30 start. For Thursday AM and Friday AM, we will leave the motel at 7:30am for an 8:00 start. In all cases, breakfast is on your own (A Village Inn is adjacent to the motel). On Thursday we will have box lunches as a working lunch is on the agenda. Thursday evening will feature a steak dinner or Bison Burgers on Konza Prairie. We will be collecting a small donation (~\$5) to cover the beer on Thursday evening. Walter Dodds and Briggs have sampled many beers to make sure that we get a good keg from the local brewery.

On Thursday, you will want to wear field clothes to the meeting, as we will leave directly from the meeting for the field. If at all possible, we will witness a burn on Konza, so bring your camera and hope that the weather cooperates. If you want, individuals can participate in lighting the fire! We encourage the wearing of cotton or wool clothing if you are going to be close to the fire. Synthetic clothing and fire do not mix well! Long pants, heavy-type shoes, hats and sun-screen are also recommended. For the weather forecast before you come, check the weather from the Konza-

LTER Home Page (<http://climate.konza.ksu.edu>) but remember the weather changes often, so be prepared. After the field trip, we will eat at Konza Prairie and then we will transport you back to the motel.

On Friday, we will provide rides back to the airport.
