Faculty agree that technology is tremendously important. The faculty thoroughly discussed whether a new emphasis should be a priority for the program. There is currently no NM Teacher License in Grade 6-12 Digital Media.	Creating a new program, to be approved through the curriculum process (Emphasis or Transcribed Certificate), including revising at least 3 existing courses is not feasible at this time. 4	The External Review team recommended that ARTE increase: "Use of digital technologies across Art Education coursework."	The ARTE faculty believe they are each currently using technology appropriately in their courses. However, they recognize the need to update the current technology and lack essential equipment for educating pre-service art teachers. The students need to learn Smart Board technology; digital editing software, including Photoshop, iMovie and Final Cut; and have access to laptop computers and projectors in Masley Hall. To accomplish these goals they propose that Masley Hall Room 209 be retrofitted with wireless bridge technology so 20 students can access the internet at one time, classes can utilize Smart Board technology with mounted projector, and wireless audio/video conferencing capabilities with software. Also, faculty need to increase their use of technology in all courses.	Purchase and installation of Smart Boar technology in Masley Hall 209 (\$4,235); purchase and installation of wireless-N and netgear access in Masley 209 (\$850); purchase and installation of computer projector in Masley 105, Masley 201 and Masley 208 (\$1100+ x 3 = \$3,300); purchase of iPads for each of the 3 ARTE faculty (\$500 x 3 = \$1,500); purchase of Kindle Fires for each of the 3 ARTE faculty (\$190 x 3 = \$570).	Approximately \$10,455 is needed. The ARTE faculty encourage the COE Dean to initiate discussions with the CFA Dean regarding licensing options for CFA MFA and BFA students. Faculty believe the time is optimal to begin conversations at the administrative level. The current Dean of the CFA has come to UNM from the Art Institute of Chicago where arts programming includes art education. Thus she likely understands BFA and MFA degrees with licensure.	This would involve continuing discussions, including at the faculty and administrative levels, with CFA advisors.	NA	The COE dean and Educational Specialties department chair attempted this with the former dean of CFA and former chair of Art & Art History but had no success. We suggest that the ARTE faculty pursue this with the current department chair of Art & Art History.	NA	NA	NA

The ARTE faculty believe that extended studio hours are good for students because they allow time for them to work on art. The ARTE faculty have already extended hours that students can use the studios by overseeing the studios on nights they teach at no additional cost to the University.	One additional work study student would be needed to monitor the studios between 5:00 and 9:00. This would be similar to the lab monitors employed by CFA in the Department of Art and Art history at \$8 for 4 hours a night or \$160/week or \$2,560/semester. The department would only pay half of the work study position.	Approximately \$5,120 would be needed to pay one work study student for two semesters.	COE is conducting a total college review of the curriculum, staff and resources, and decisions about these issues for all COE programs will be made after the review is completed. 7	The External Review team recommended that ARTE consider: "Increase GA and/or TA positions" or hire a Lecturer III.	Currently a .5 GA per semester assists faculty with Masley Gallery. In their final sentiments, reviewers suggest to "Hire a Lecturer 3 or 2 TA's to take over student teaching placements, observations and other supervisory duties." This is an important component to freeing up faculty time that can be better used to teach community and/or museum education in the MA, Media (Visual Culture) Literacy and/or grades 6-12 Digital Media Licensure, and to remain vibrant as researchers.	THE COE Field Services Office (FSO) hires GA's and PTI's to supervise student teachers. Faculty members have requested a Lecturer 3 position four times to oversee the student teaching placements, seminar and observations and other courses. A Lecturer 3 is preferable to TA's since there is no Ph.D. offered in ARTE, therefore no PH.D level TA's are available. Most MA students do not have prior teaching experience as most are seeking the MA plus licensure coursework. This would require new sources of funding and allocation from the college.	Lecturer 3 - \$48,000.	COE is conducting a total college review of the curriculum, staff and resources, and decisions about these issues for all COE programs will be made after the review is completed.	The ARTE faculty are invited to submit a faculty hiring request, with appropriate rationale and back up data, to be submitted in April when all requests for new faculty are submitted to the chairs and deans group.
