

You can change the screen in any way you see fit. Right click on the border of the windows you will see a pop-up menu that has two choices, Split Area and No Header. Select Split Area and you will see a line to divide the window into another window. You can change the view to have two different perspectives. For instance in one window you can see in perspective mode and in another you can see it in Side view.

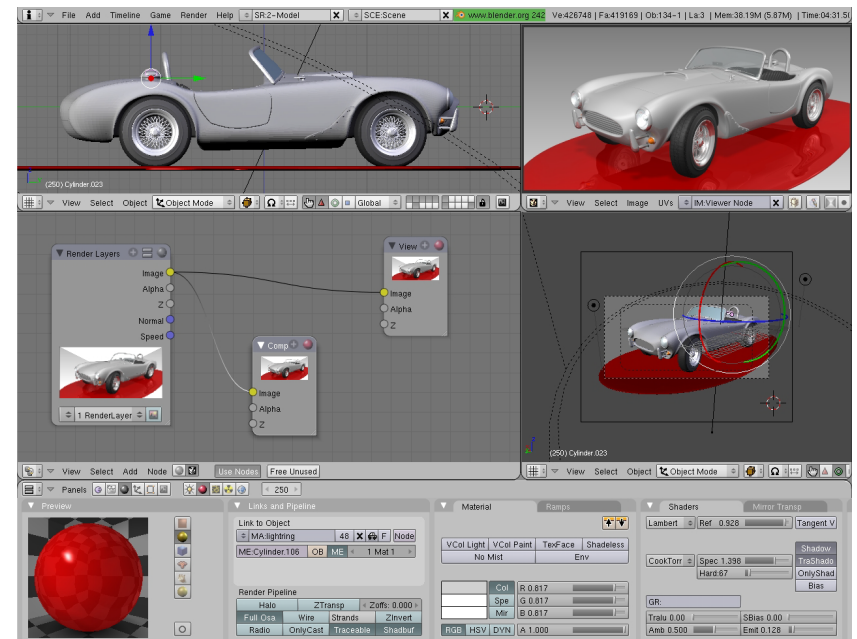
