Went reining with R. Travel.

WJK39-04-22-01

Served Conservancy ditch on N. Second St. two miles N. of Albuquerque city limit.

Water, white-turbid; Bottom mud; Vegetation sparse; width 5-8 ft; depth 1-2 feet. Not much differentiation of pools and riffles. Weather cloudless. A. 82.5 W 67.5 2.10 PM.

Served. from 1:50 - 2:10 PM. Covered about 75 feet of ditch.

Fingering trout were common (about 8 taken) but seemed lean. One was lacking the right operculum.

P. pipiens - 1 mass of eggs, 3 adults seen.

Bufo woodhousii 1 ad. seen.

Served Conservancy ditch on N. Second St. 5.3 miles N. of city line. Apparently same ditch as preceding but larger. Width 12 feet; depth - 3 feet. Water, white, turbid; Vegetation sparse, chiefly along shore; Bottom muck and mud. Temperature A. 83.0 W. 70.5 T. 3.00 PM.
