Ray Gill and I seined the riverside drain just north of Bernalillo for about  $1\frac{1}{2}$  hours. At 15°C at 12 noon S.T. We used the 6, 10, and 25 foot seines. Bottom sand and silt, a little gravel in one place. Current generally rather strong. Vegetation moderately abundant. Depth up to 4 feet, generally about two <sup>to three</sup>. We were after Tinca. I believe one was in the seine but it got away.
